

Full-time Interim Rector – St. Michael’s Episcopal Church, Carmichael, CA

St. Michael’s Episcopal Church is a welcoming, inclusive community centered in our Love for Jesus Christ. Together, we worship God, reach out to those in need, celebrate our blessings, and love and care for each other. We seek a **full-time Interim Priest** to minister and provide pastoral care to our congregation during this period of discernment as we seek a new leader after the retirement of a beloved long-term rector. Our location:

St. Michael’s Episcopal Church is located in suburban metropolitan Sacramento, California and is strategically located near both downtown and exurban cultural and employment centers.

Tasks:

Work with the Vestry and lay leaders to:

- Maintain a regular schedule of worship and preaching
- Support Bible Studies, Godly Play Sunday School, contemplative offerings, music program and various outreach programs
- Provide pastoral care
- Lead pastoral offices (e.g., baptisms, weddings, and funerals)
- Support the Vestry in the ongoing administration of the parish
- Help the church move toward calling their next rector (in close partnership with the Canon to the Ordinary)
- Help to build relationships within the wider community, including St. Michael’s Episcopal Day School, and participate in interfaith and community events.

Qualifications:

- Strong communication and interpersonal skills
- Experience with transition ministry (or willingness to learn)
- Demonstrated experience in preaching/ reaching parishioners across generations.

Compensation:

- Salary Range: \$102,000 to \$122,000 per annum, depending on experience.
- Full medical and dental benefits for clergy and family, plus clergy pension.
- 4 weeks paid vacation, 2 weeks sick leave, and 2 weeks continuing education.
