We are Jesus-centered with fidelity to the Book of Common Prayer while maintaining inclusivity in our ministries.

Our campus, a mix of 19th and 20th-century buildings, is in the historic district of Folsom, a suburb of Sacramento, and just completed a significant restoration and expansion project, with the construction loan fully paid off this year.

Our staff, currently composed of a full-time Assistant Rector, a part-time Priest Associate, a semiretired Priest Associate, a full-time parish administrator (currently hiring), a full-time director of music, a full-time director of children's ministries, and a part-time office administrator, enjoys working collaboratively and is well-supported by the parish.

We have four Sunday services and Sunday School for children and adults between the two largest Sunday morning services. We have grown significantly since 2012 when our average Sunday attendance was 132; it is currently 233 (and even higher pre-COVID), and our attendance continues to rise post-COVID. During the 10-year tenure of our last rector, we rebuilt our programs and buildings, and we are debt free.

We have active outreach ministries that faithfully serve our community, on and off our campus, with both volunteers and sharing of our financial resources.

This position will include, but is not limited to, the Sunday rotation of preaching and eucharistic duties, pastoral care, leading the weekly book group, compline, teaching Sunday School for adults, leading weekly staff meetings, mentoring staff, and office operations.

We seek a rector whose preaching reflects a vibrant personal faith in Jesus Christ, and who is:

- Inclusive while gracefully navigating a polarized world.

This position pays \$108,000/year, plus full health benefits (priest only, additional family members may be included at own cost). We are fully compliant with the Episcopal Church Pension Fund.
